

APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION ON THE ELECTORAL ROLL

You must be registered on the electoral roll to vote in an election. Norwegian citizens resident in a foreign country who have not been registered in the National Population Register as resident in Norway at any time in the last 10 years before election day, must apply to be registered on the electoral roll to be able to vote in an election.

An application form for registration is printed on the containing envelope used for advance voting overseas, on Svalbard and Jan Mayen. You can also use the form below if you wish. If you prefer to write a regular letter, you must remember to provide all of the information requested in the application.

The application must be sent to the election board in the municipality in which you were last registered as resident in Norway. The application must reach the election board before 17.00 the day after election day.

If you have been registered in the National Population Register at any time in the last 10 years before election day, you will be automatically included in the electoral roll in the municipality where you were registered as resident when you moved out of Norway.
